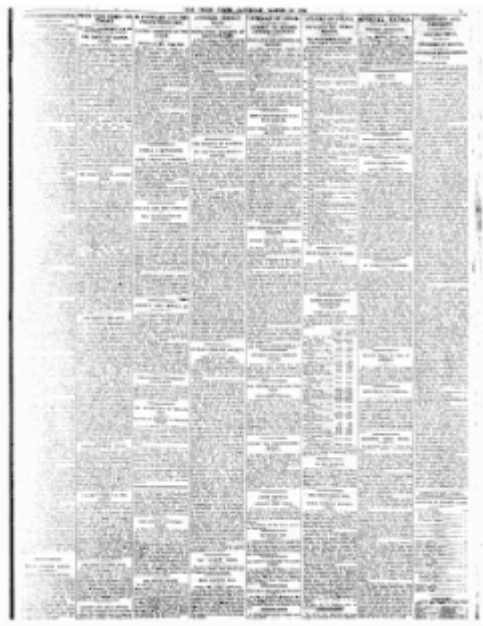

OBITUARY.

DR. W. SNOW BURNSIDE.

We regret to announce the death of Dr. W. Snow Burnside, M.A., Sc.D., ex-Senior Fellow of Trinity College, Dublin, which took place on Thursday at his residence, 35 Raglan road, Dublin. Dr. Burnside, who was the third son of the late W. S. Burnside, D.D., was a mathematician of eminence, and, in conjunction with the late Dr. Panton, he wrote that well-known work, "The Theory of Equations." So far back as the year 1859 he was Mathematical Scholar in Trinity College, and in the year 1862 he took his degree. Nine years later he was elected a Fellow, and in 1879 he became Professor of Mathematics. A few years ago Dr. Burnside resigned his Senior Fellowship owing to failing health. The interment will take place in the family vault at Fivemiletown, County Tyrone, on Monday afternoon.
